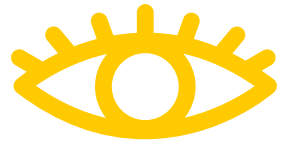

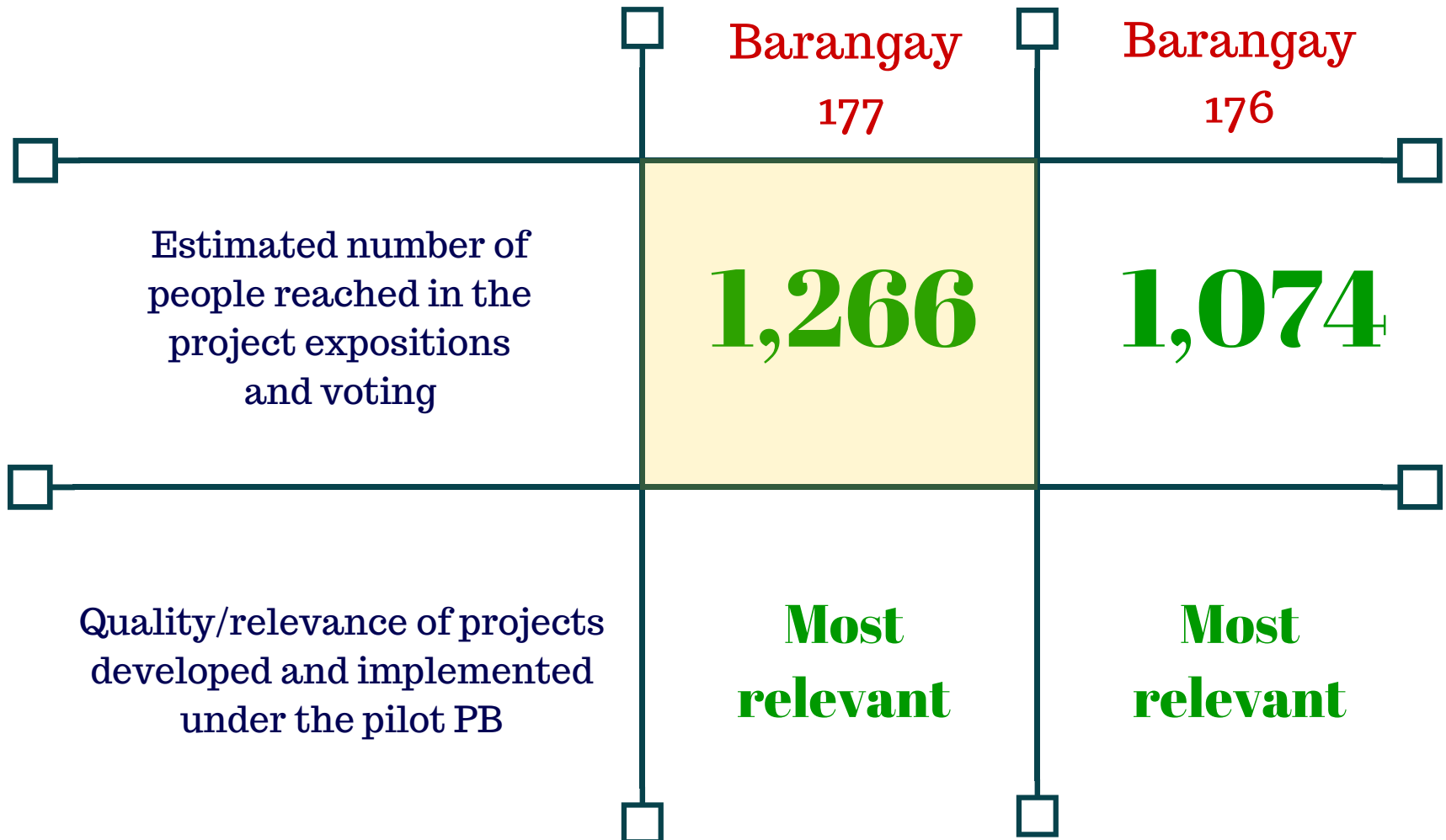

Check My Barangay is a participatory governance initiative focusing at the barangay level.

Participatory governance

"Participatory governance consists of state-sanctioned institutional processes that allow citizens to exercise voice and vote, which then results in the implementation of public policies that produce some sort of changes in citizens' lives" (Wampler and McNulty, 2011).

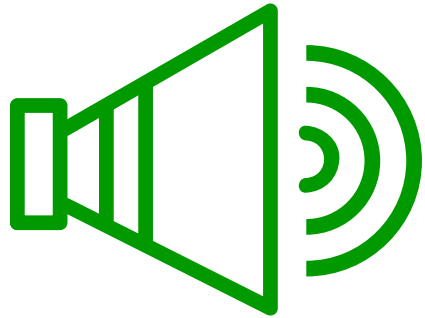
'Participatory governance' denotes forms of governance in which non-governmental actors (usually 'citizens') are empowered to use the resources of the State to make decisions about matters that directly concern them (Stewart, 2009).

implemented projects and programs.



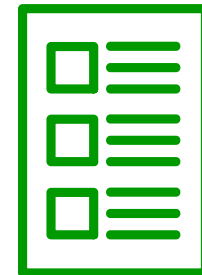
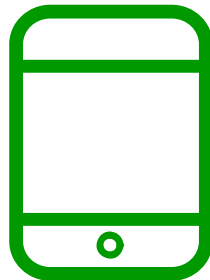
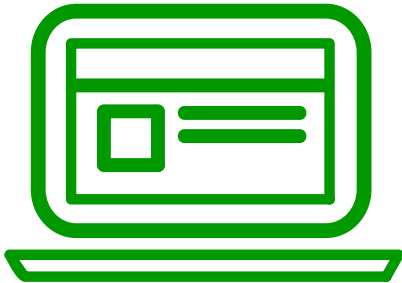


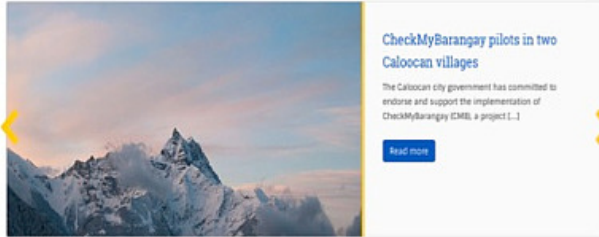
In addition, the project seeks to empower the community by providing mechanisms and avenues for participation with respect to the systemic dissemination of the project and program-relevant information in the barangay processes.

It is a tool for monitoring the computer system of the barangay.

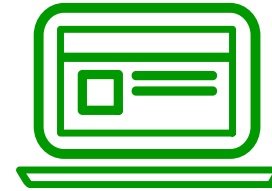
Budgeting

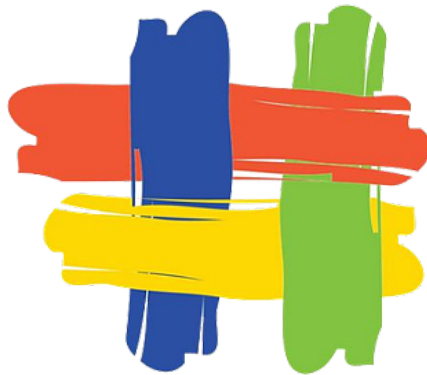
