A RESOLUTION CALLING ALL THE CONSTITUENTS OF THIS DIOCESE FOR A CONSTRUCTIVE ENGAGEMENT IN THE MONITORING OF FUND, PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS OF THE GOVERNMENT AND ITS AGENCIES

Whereas, the President is encouraging the Civil Society organizations (CSO) and Faith Based Organization to participate in the monitoring of government's funds, programs, and projects thru the value of Transparency and Accountability.

Whereas, various government agencies like DPWH, DILG, NCIP, COMELEC, DBM, office of the ombudsman and many others are interested to tap CSOs and faith based organizations in the monitoring of its funds, programs and projects.

Be it therefore resolved that in the spirit of 'makilahok' rather than 'makilahom', the Episcopal Diocese of Santiago and all its constituents will engage the government and its agencies in an constructive mode as it fully expresses the Universal declaration on Human Rights (Article 21 section 1) when it states "Everyone has the right to take part in the government of his/her country, directly or through freely chosen representations.
