Event Overview

Beginning in 2007, regional "ANSAs" have been established in Africa, East-Asia Pacific, South Asia and recently in the Middle East. Each of the regional ANSAs is hosted by a local institution, which is housed in a secretariat that acts as the hub of the network. The networks serve as clearing houses of information, facilitate knowledge exchange on social accountability mechanisms and tools and provide opportunities for capacity building and networking amongst practitioners.

ANSA Global was created to support social accountability in regions where ANSAs are not established through providing project grants to civil society organizations and building capacities and competencies within both state and civil society institutions. ANSA Global serves as a global connector of the regional ANSA chapters to share the experiences and lessons learned from the different networks through the facilitation of knowledge exchange and peer-to-peer visits. This event will officially launch ANSA Global and chart next steps for a way forward.

Event Objectives

The proposed regional gathering hosted by ANSA-EAP aims to convene the ANSA global panel, the equivalent of Executive Committee for ANSA Global. It shall have the following specific objectives:

- 1. Officially launch the ANSA Global hub;
- 2. Share lessons from ANSAs;
- 3. Facilitate information exchange among ANSAs and other regional partners; and
- 4. Discuss the way forward for ANSA Global.
