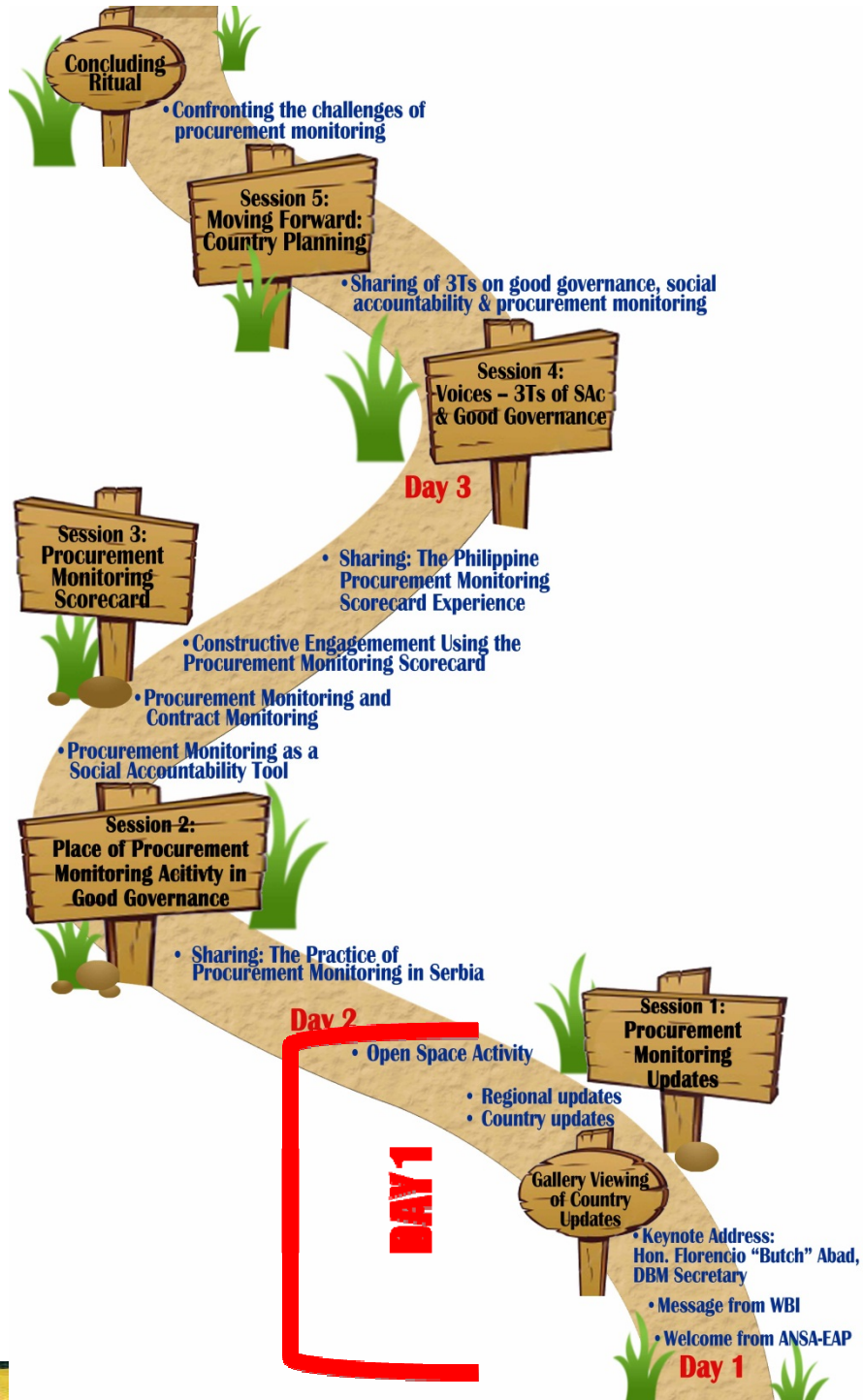
To present updates from network partners about the tales, tools, and techniques (3Ts) in citizen monitoring, specifically on procurement and other PFM processes
